- **GE – Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program**

Application Deadline: January 4, 2018

\$10,000 per year up to \$40,000

To be eligible for the GE – Reagan Foundation Scholarship applicants must demonstrate at school, at the workplace, and within the community the attributes of leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship. Applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher (4.0 scale), must be citizens of the USA, and must plan to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study toward a bachelor's degree at an accredited four – year college or university in the US for the entire upcoming school year. In addition, semifinalists must be nominated by an eligible community leader, such as a high school principal, elected official or executive director of a nonprofit organization, and must provide documentation to certify academic performance and financial need. Finalists will be interviewed via Skype or phone. Applications are online.

Scholarships are awarded for the full or partial cost of an Off Campus room for one year at Town Lake in Austin, The Ridge at North Texas, and the Cambridge in College Station, or at an alternate comparable facility if designated by Texas Student Housing.

Application Deadline: **MARCH 23, 2018** to Mrs. Schubach (this is different from the date on the application)

Applicants must be a US Citizen, have a 3.0 or higher GPA, have an acceptance letter from the college or university you plan to attend, and have a copy of your SAR (Student Aid Report FAFSA). Applications will need to be turned in to Mrs. Schubach by March 23rd in order to be considered for selection.
