

**DISTRICT 14 AAA (Div. 2)
TIE-BREAKER POLICY**

METHOD OF DETERMINING DISTRICT REPRESENTATIVES WHEN MORE THAN TWO TEAMS ARE TIED FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP POSITION

At the end of the season, if there is a multiple tie (more than two) in percentage for the champion, the teams involved shall be declared tri-champions, etc.

In the case of ties involving more than two teams, the following method (points spread) will be used to determine the ranking for the play-offs.

A. POINT SPREAD OF SCORES

Consider only the scores of the games in which the teams involved played. The maximum spread of points allowed any one team in any one game shall be 18 points. The team tied with the highest net score shall be the number one rank, next highest net score is number two rank and the next highest net score is number three rank. In case of a three-way tie and two of the teams end up with the same net points, we would revert back to the score of the two teams involved.

Example of 3-way tie with scores/points

In case of any tie, we will follow these steps in this order.

1. Head-up
2. Point Spread of Scores (Positive/Negative)
3. Coin Flip
