

UIL District Junior High/Elementary Academic Plan

1. Establish and determine Meet Site and Date:

Elementary: North Zone hosted by Newgulf Elementary (**Saturday, November 12, 2016**)

Schools: Boling, Tidehaven, and Van Vleck

South Zone hosted by Industrial (**Saturday, January 21, 2017**)

Edna, Industrial, and Palacios

Junior High School: Hosted by Industrial Junior High (**Wednesday, January 18, 2017**) @ 1:00 PM

Schools: Boling, Edna, Industrial, Palacios, Tidehaven, and Van Vleck

2. Events to be offered: (See attached list on page 3 & 4)
3. Contest structure: (See attached list on page 3 & 4)
4. Contest times: To be announced by hosting schools for different events.
5. Financing of meet will be shared equally by all participating schools. Mr. Blonar will pay all expenses and forward shared expenses to each school. Student meals will be paid by individual schools (number of students eating will be turned in to host school for planning purposes).
6. Awards: Boling ISD will order the awards. There will be three divisions; 2-5; 6; 7/8. Each division will have a first place and runner-up plaque for junior high and Elementary North Zone Competition. Individual places will receive medals for places 1-3 and place ribbons for places 4-6. All participants will receive a ribbon. We will purchase extra medals and ribbons for ties.
7. Awards will be presented in packets prepared for each school.
8. Entry forms (please list students with their number on the entry form) will be due on: Elementary North – October 12, 2016 email Elementary forms to Gerald Floyd at gfloyd@bolingisd.net . Elementary South-January 11, 2017 email entry forms to Anne McCain at amccain@iisd1.org . Junior High –Email all entries to Caleb McCain at cmccain@iisd1.org by January 11, 2017 with writing entries being due January 4, 2017.
9. Writing events will be held prior to contest dates on individual campuses.

Elementary North: Creative Writing and Ready Writing will take place on October 12, 2016 at each school's individual campus and entries due October 5, 2016. Test materials (writing) need to be mailed attention **Sara Roper (Van Vleck Elementary 178 S. 4th Street, Van Vleck, Texas 77482)** and must be posted marked no later than October 14, 2016.

Elementary South: Creative Writing and Ready Writing will take place during the week of December 5th-9th at each school's individual campus with entries being due December 1, 2016, to Anne McCain. Anne McCain will send out additional writing information, during the month of November.

Junior High: Ready Writing and Editorial Writing needs to be completed by January 11, 2017 at each school's individual campus. Email entries to Caleb McCain at cmccain@iisd1.org by January 4,

2017. Ready Writing and Editorial Writing must be brought to the Grading Meeting by the writing coaches (2 per participating school) at Edna Junior High (grading begins at 1:00 p.m.).

10. Students may enter one writing and one speech contest and any event non- conflicting with the main UIL contest. (Note: maximum of 4 events). For elementary, check with individual zone host.
11. Junior High speech events will be held on January 17, 2017 at 4:00 PM. Caleb McCain will contact other participating school districts at a later date for a list of 5 judges from each individual district. There will be 3 judges for preliminary and finals rounds. Names, instead of numbers, will be used to identify Oral Reading, Impromptu Speaking, and Modern Oratory participants at the competition. Only prose pieces will be accepted in 6th, 7th & 8th grades for 2016-2017. The documentation must be emailed/mailed to Caleb McCain by January 11, 2017 to be checked.
12. Each contest director will select and train judges according to the UIL rules and regulations. For the Art Contest, refer to the Art Smart Bulletin Official list, answers have to be given as listed in this bulletin. The elementary south zone will take both sections A and B, on the Art Smart Test.
13. Music Memory: Grades 3/4/5 will use 3/4 grade test (matching test).
14. Additional information will be sent as contests approach by Gerald Floyd for Elementary North and Anne McCain for Elementary South. Caleb McCain from Industrial Junior High will send out information for 6, 7/8.
15. Note that entry forms **will be emailed**.
16. Numbers will be assigned to contestants. Same number will be used in case of participation in two events.
17. Alternates may be moved to other events. If a contestant is not listed on the entry form, the student will not be allowed to participate. Only one alternate may be listed per contest with the exception of Art and Music (may list 2 alternates).
18. Maps, Graphs, Charts, use any atlas, Nystrom Desk Atlas recommended, student may take only one Atlas into the contest.
19. Staff and students are not to wear identifying school clothing.
20. Speaking events, list best speaker first, 2nd best second and so on. 3 judges to be used in preliminaries and finals.
21. Refer to the 2016-2017 UIL A+ Handbook for rules not mentioned in this document.
22. Each school is responsible for monitoring its own students. Each school should provide a monitor for all student areas (gym, playground, cafeteria, etc.).
