

## **Guide for Prospective Boling Independent School District Purchasers**

Boling ISD Board Policy CI (Local) authorizes the Superintendent or designee to declare District materials, equipment, and supplies to be unnecessary and shall dispose of unnecessary materials, equipment, and supplies for fair market value. Disposal will be managed via a central office public notice and online bidding format. Prospective purchasers may view details and pictures of the disposed products either in person at the bus garage or online ([www.bolingisd.net](http://www.bolingisd.net)). If interested, prospective purchasers can submit a sealed bid in person, by mail, or email before the posted deadline.

Boling ISD advises purchasers to read the conditions of sale printed in the terms of agreement. By bidding, bidders are bound by the conditions of sale as a contract between the successful bidder (purchaser) and the seller of Boling ISD. Boling ISD recommends that all prospective purchasers view the auction on-line only.

### **Condition of Products**

All products are sold "as is"

### **Payment**

Payment by cash, money order, or personal check is accepted. Checks should be made payable to Boling Independent School District. All products must be paid for and removal arrangements made following the close of the Bids.

### **Removal of Property**

Product will be released to the purchaser upon confirmation of payment. Unless other arrangements have been agreed upon, all items awarded must be picked up between the hours 8:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. by the pick-up deadline. If the pick-up deadline expires, the item will be awarded to the next highest bidder. The packing, loading, and shipping of items are solely the purchaser's responsibility and at the purchaser's expense.

### **CONDITIONS OF SALE FOR BENEFIT AUCTION**

All purchases are subject to the following terms and conditions, as amended by any posted notices during the sale, which govern the sale of all of the Products offered at the auction:

1. (a) BOLING INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT ASSUMES NO RISK, LIABILITY, OR RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE AUTHENTICITY OF PRODUCT OFFERED AT THE AUCTION.

(b) ALL PRODUCTS ARE SOLD "AS IS" AND BOLING INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT MAKES NO REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND OR NATURE, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, WITH RESPECT TO THE PRODUCT, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, AND IN NO EVENT SHALL BOLING INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CORRECTNESS OF THE PRODUCT OR NOTICES OR DESCRIPTIONS OF THE PRODUCT, NOR BE DEEMED TO HAVE MADE ANY REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY OF OWNERSHIP, PHYSICAL CONDITION, SIZE, QUALITY, RARITY, IMPORTANCE, GENUINENESS, ATTRIBUTION, AUTHENTICITY, PROVENANCE, OR HISTORICAL RELEVANCE OF THE PRODUCT.

No statement, notice, or description made in any Bill of Sale, Invoice, or elsewhere shall be deemed such a representation or warranty, or any assumption of liability by Boling Independent School District.

2. Any Product may be withdrawn by Boling Independent School District at any time before the final bidding date without any liability.
