

Notice: Iago JH Construction Project

Over the holiday break, our Iago Junior High Classroom & Office Addition Project has officially started. Construction fencing has been installed and preliminary construction initiated. Our construction team is determined to keep related disruptions to a minimum, but as with any construction project, we must anticipate enduring a certain level of inconveniences. Keeping this and our student/staff safety in mind, please consider the following information:

- **Parent Drop-Off:** We anticipate the parent drop-off area at Iago Junior High (IJH) to become very congested during construction. To help alleviate this problem and to avoid delays during construction throughout the Spring semester, we sincerely ask that parents/guardians not drop off their children at the IJH Campus until after 7:15 a.m. in the mornings (after the early bus routes) unless it is absolutely necessary. We also discourage parents from using the street (Gift Drive) as a drop-off location, encouraging instead to use the parent/bus loading area in front of the band hall.
- **Visitors on Campus:** Parent involvement at BISD is encouraged, but please remember to check in at the office upon arrival. This project will change the storefront dramatically. While the front entrances are designed to be utilized during an emergency, they will not be routinely used during construction. During construction, please follow the temporary signage closely and enter the office area from the back of the main building.
- **Parking:** Parking will be limited to the parking area West of the campus. Parking in front of the construction fencing and construction staging area (across the street from the library) will not be allowed throughout the Spring Semester.
- **Extra-Curricular:** Basketball practice will remain at IJH as planned, but the remaining home games (boys & girls) will be played at the Boling High School Gymnasium. Currently game times will remain as scheduled.
